Lead Soldier: Company Halt! Gather people!

Lead Soldier: People of Nazareth. An urgent order has come from Ceaser Augustus! Read Order!

Other Soldier: All the world must now be taxed. Each man must travel to the city of his origin to be counted and taxed. IT is the king's order; therefore; it's got to be carried out.

Lead Soldier: Company! Fall in! ROME two three four ROME two three four.

Mics ON: 1,4 (as soon as Mary and Joseph receive their mics)

Man at table 1: Taxes, taxes. You know every nation that ever fell, fell because of taxes?

Man 2: That's the truth. Remember Assyria? Taxes.

Other men murmur in agreement

Man 3: And Babylon? Taxes.

Other men murmur in agreement

Man 1: Jerusalem after Solomon's reign? Taxes.

Joseph: We need to get started. This will be a difficult trip with you in your condition. What timing! If only you could have had the baby first. I suppose Jehovah knows what He is doing though.

Mary: We'll be fine Joseph. Surely Jehovah will be with us.

Mary: "Joseph, we are both aware that all this is mysterious. We just can't understand it. But both of us being believers, we know that Jehovah has something in store, and that He has chosen us; and has chosen me above the women of the world today to have this Message concealed in my heart."

Wise Man 1: "It says here in the prophecy of Daniel that There would be a Stone cut out of the mountain, without hands. – Very interesting"

Wise Man 2: Yes, certainly you do not feel it means a physical stone.

Smaller Wise Man: Do you think it is a type or shadow of something to come?

Wise Man 1: Very good young wise one.
